II. Presentation Aim: This contest provides students with valuable learning experiences on developing communication/critical thinking skills and raising awareness of important global issues in order to cultivate students' world citizenship literacy.

IV. Registration Rules and Regulations

(A) Qualifications

1. 4-year college ESP/EAP students **as well as Level 6/B1b students** at WZU
2. ROC residents, non-English native speakers, with official student status
3. Those who haven't lived in any English-speaking countries for longer than six months after the age of six
4. Those who haven't attended any schools (bilingual schools, including any overseas study programs or exchange student programs) or in any English-speaking countries for longer than six months after the age of six

(B) Participants

Group A (Translation, English, International Affairs, Foreign Language Instruction): individual work

Group B (French, German, Japanese, Spanish, International Business Administration, Communication Arts, Digital Content Application and Management, Applied Chinese, and Southeast Asian Studies): individual work

(C) Restrictions

When registering, please attach your presentation outline. At most 12 individual students from Session A and 12 individual students from Session B will be selected based on their outline content.

(A) Dates

1. Deadline of Registration: **May 3, 2023 (Wed.) by 23:59**
2. Date for List of Participants: **May 5, 2023 (Fri.) by 17:00**
3. Contest Date & Time: May 24, 2023 (Wed.) 15:10~17:00
4. Presentation Venue & Order: The order of presentation will be determined by CELT. The results of the presentation order and the exact location will be announced on **May 5 (Fri.)** on the CELT homepage.
5. Contest Results & Awards: the announcement will be made immediately after the contest.
6. All participants' PPT content is required to submit to 100568@gap.wzu.edu.tw before **12:00 noon on May 16th, 2023**, with the email title "Participant's Chinese name/student ID/group A or B- 2023English Presentation Contest"

(B) Method

1. Length of Presentation
 - (1) 3 minutes for each presentation
 - (2) A 1-minute Q&A will be conducted after the presentation.

3. Content
 - (1) Students can utilize the concepts from education, economics, politics, culture, and international relations to elaborate their understanding of “the future of warfare”.
 - (2) Participants are allowed to name their topics on the thesis of the theme to create their presentation content.
4. Only registered participants are allowed to perform on the stage.
5. No script is allowed when giving the presentation.
6. If the contest is affected by the epidemic, the online competition method and entry process will be announced separately.

(C) Presentation File

1. References should be properly listed if needed. Please refer to the link to APA citation document:

2. **Microsoft PowerPoint** or **Google Slide** should be used. English must be used as the medium of presentation.
3. All participants’ PPT content is required to submit to 100568@gap.wzu.edu.tw before **12:00pm on May 16th, 2023**, with the email title “**Participant’s Chinese name/student ID/group A or B- 2023English Presentation Contest**”.

(D) Evaluation

1. 50%: Speech skills and delivery: enunciation, intonation, fluency, accuracy, interview, etc.
2. 40%: Content: relevance, creativity, organization, visual aids
3. 10%: Performance: gestures, postures, dress code
4. Attention: Without proper APA citation, your slides will be returned.

(E) Contest Rules

1. All participants should check in before 15:10 on May 24, 2023.
2. Each presenter will be called three times. If not in attendance, the presenter will forfeit the contest.
3. All participants are required to use the provided microphone.
