# 2025 Wenzao English Read Aloud Contest

- **I. Purpose:** This contest aims to enhance students' motivation and interest in learning English through the experience of a read-aloud competition.
- II. Organizer: Center for English Language Teaching (CELT), Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages
- **III. Date:** May 21, 2025 (Wednesday), 15:00-17:00

## IV. Registration:

- A. Contestant Qualifications:
  - 1. Undergraduate freshmen in the Day Division of the 4-year college currently taking General English courses from Level 1 to Level 6 (non-English native international students included)
  - 2. Registered full-time students
  - 3. Students with no experience staying in any English-speaking country or studying in any English language school (including bilingual or international schools) for over six months
- B. Entry Quota:

A maximum of two students (three for Level 1) from each class can sign up for the contest.

#### V. Procedures:

- A. Important dates:
  - 1. Registration Period: From now until April 25 (Friday) at 23:59
  - 2. Announcement of Contestants: The list of contestants will be posted on the center's website by May 2 (Friday) at 17:00.
  - 3. Announcement of Competition Results: The results will be announced on the day of the competition, May 21 (Wednesday), and will be posted on the center's website the following day.

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### E. Regulations

- 1. Participants must present their student ID and complete check-in at Q201/Q202 classrooms between 15:00 and 15:20 on the day of the event to confirm their performance order. Participants who fail to complete check-in before the competition check-in deadline (15:20) will be considered as having forfeited their participation.
- 2. Participants should adhere to the principle of neat and formal attire.
- 3. Competition Procedure:
  - a. Participants will draw one out of the three assigned reading materials on-site and begin reading immediately.
  - b. The reading time is limited to 2 minutes. A reminder bell will ring once at 1 minute 50 seconds, and an ending bell will ring twice at 2 minutes to signal the completion of the reading.
  - c. One winner will be selected for each level. The results will be announced immediately after the competition, followed by the award ceremony.
- 4. Criteria for Evaluation:
  - a. Pronunciation and Enunciation: 30%
  - b. Fluency: 30%
  - c. Intonation and Expression: 30%
  - d. Attire and Posture: 10%
  - \* In the event of a tie, the ranking will be determined in the following order: (1) pronunciation and Enunciation, (2) Fluency, and (3) Intonation and Expression.

## VI. Prizes:

A winner will be selected for each English proficiency level by the judges, and they will be awarded a certificate and 500 NTD.

Note: All contestants will receive a certificate of participation.
