

Ink War: English Handwriting Battle

1. Purpose: In response to the decline of English handwriting skills among university students in the digital age, this competition uses on-site English story handwriting as its main format. It encourages students to recognize the importance of English handwriting in language learning. Through the competition, students are guided to pay attention to legibility, neatness, and overall presentation in English writing, and to develop good handwriting habits and better written expression.

4. Registration

(1) Eligibility: This competition is open to Wenzao students who are officially enrolled in General English courses (Levels 1–6) or ESP/EAP/EGP courses.

(2) Number of Participants: The competition is limited to 30 participants.
Registration will close when the limit is reached.

5. Competition Schedule

(1) Important Dates:

1. Registration Period: From now until April 10th, 2026 (Wednesday), 5:00 p.m.

2. Announcement of Participants: April 15th (Wednesday), by 5:00 p.m.,
on the Center for English Language Teaching website.

3. **On-site Competition Date:** May 6, 2026 (Wednesday) from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

4. **Announcement of Preliminary Results:** May 15, 2026 (Friday), posted on the Center's website.

5. **Announcement of Final Results:** May 27, 2026 (Wednesday), posted on the Center's website.

(3) Competition Time: 20 minutes

6. Competition Rules

(1) Check-in: Participants must bring their student ID and check in at the classroom Q 203 between 3:00 p.m. and 3:20 p.m. on the competition day. Participants who fail to check in by 3:20 p.m. will be considered absent and disqualified.

(2) Competition Format

1. **On-site English Handwriting:** The competition must be completed in **handwritten English block letters (print)**. All writing materials (pens and paper) will be provided

by CELT.

2. **Topic Announcement:** The content to be written will be revealed on-site on the day of the competition.
3. **Collection of Submissions:** Once the competition concludes, all works will be collected by the event staff.

(3) Selection Process:

Preliminary Round: After the competition, the judges will select the top 10 works from the 30 participants.

Final Round: The top 10 works will be put to a vote across General English courses (including ESP, EAP, and EGP). The **top 3 winners** will be determined by a combined vote from instructors and students, with the final results compiled and announced by CELT.

(4) Judging Criteria:

1. **Legibility 25%:** Writing is clear and easy to read; words are easily identifiable without the reader needing to guess the content.
2. **Consistency 25%:** Handwriting style is stable, with uniform letter sizing and overall stylistic consistency.
3. **Spacing 25%:** Appropriate spacing between letters, words, and lines, ensuring a comfortable reading experience that is neither crowded nor overly sparse.
4. **Neatness 25%:** The work is clean and aesthetically pleasing, free of excessive corrections, with well-planned layout and excellent visual presentation.

7. Awards:

- (1) The top three winners will each receive a certificate and a cash prize of NT\$500.
- (2) All participants who complete the competition will receive a certificate of participation.
