The Script for the Reader Theater

SCENE 1. (Alessia goes to visit Cheryl's new home.) (PPT: Living room)

Linda: Oops.. My period is coming! Could you lend me a sanitary napkin?

Cheryl: Of course. Here you are.

Linda: Thank you!

(Alessia comes back from the toilet)

Linda: I feel more comfortable now. Sanitary napkins are really something essential for women through the period.

Cheryl: I agree with you, but do you know what exactly sanitary napkins are made of?

Linda: Emm... I don't know. Maybe we can check it on the label.

Narrator: Non-woven fabric, pulp, and waterproof membrane made by Kotex, Indonesia. (PPT)

Linda: It turns out that there are these components in sanitary napkins! But why? Why do you choose Kotex?

Cheryl: I think this brand is the most comfortable one! Moreover, it also established a foundation to help women!

Narrator: Aside from producing essential sanitary napkins, Kotex established "She Can" Foundation offering education and funds for those women with dreams.

"She Can" Foundation: Every woman has the right to chase their own dream! "Period or not, she can."

All: Yes.

Cheryl: Of course! Let me tell you Santi's story!

Narrator: Santi Setyaningsih, being hearing-impaired, is one of the beneficiaries of this foundation. With hearing limitations, Santi encountered some unfair treatment.

SCENE 2. (Santi is applying for a job in a company.) (PPT: picture of interview)

Interviewer: I think you're not a good fit for our company.

Santi: Why not?

Interviewer: We don't want to hire someone who is hearing-impaired!

Santi: It won't affect me at work! I promise!

Interviewer: Sorry! Next one!

SCENE 3. (Santi happened to know about the "She Can" Foundation) (PPT:computer)

Narrator: Santi is sad and she decided to build her own company.

Santi: I want to have my own company and help other disabled people!

(Action : $(\Box)^{-1}$) \leftarrow like this)(**PPT**: **picture of** $(\Box)^{-1}$)

Narrator: But she didn't have any support in the beginning. Fortunately, Santi happened to know about the "She Can" Foundation.

(Action: Santi is searching on the internet)

Santi: Emm? She can Foundation? (PPT: web page) Maybe I can try it!

SCENE 4. (Santi received help from the "She Can" Foundation) (PPT: office)(Do it at same time)

Narrator: "She can" foundation provides funds to support Santi to build a company, Creativeable Project, empowering Micro, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (MSMEs) for disabled people through art, craft, and photography.

"She Can" Foundation: Here's the money. Let us help you.

Santi: With your help, I built my company, Creativeable Project. Thank you. Now, I am going to help others!

SCENE 5. (At the workshop, Santi was teaching the disabled people to do some handicraft. The voice of teaching is heard in the distance...) (PPT: workshop)

Santi: OK, next step, make the clay into animal shapes.....

Narrator: Besides, she built a community, Kutilang Riau, developing the potential of those hearing-impaired youth and nurtured the first sign language interpreter.

Santi: (sign language: thank you / hello, we will show the words on PPT and do the gesture)

Narrator: Thanks to "She Can" Foundation, Santi has empowered herself to pay it forward!
