<b>Scene 2 – Ahmad's on his way to the factory</b>		
Ahmad	<b>I know we need the money. But I really want to take a break. I'm really feeling sick. (*sign)</b>	Frustrated and helpless.
<b>Scene 3 – At the soccer factory</b>		
Narrator	<b>Since Ahmad isn't feeling the best, he walks slowly to work. It takes him twice the time to get to the soccer factory. He arrives at work late.</b>	No emotion but speak fluently
Boss	Why are you late? You have to sew at least five soccer balls today or you cannot go home or get paid.	Impatient <b>and angry</b>
Ahmad	Sorry, I got a cold so I woke up late this morning. I am really sorry. I will try my best to sew as many soccer balls as I can.	Trembling and tired.
Narrator	Although Ahmad hates his life but he really needs to make money for the family. One day, a reporter visits the soccer factory. After her interview, she realizes the secret behind every soccer.	No emotion but speak fluently.
Reporter	I have heard that your factory is the biggest factory in	No emotion

	Pakistan.	but speak fluently.
Boss	Yeah, we have a lot of employees and we produce over 60 million soccer balls every year to meet the demand. We give our workers a pretty good wage and <b>a safe</b> working environment.	Full of confidence.
Reporter	Oh, really? Could you show us more?	Accepted boss's reply but still doubted.

Narrator	When the reporter knows Ahmad works at the factory, she is more curious about how much he earns and the working environment whether it is the same as the boss mentioned earlier.	No emotion but speak fluently.
Reporter	So how much do you get paid every day?	Confused and curious.
Ahmad	About 4 NT dollars. Sometimes I don't get pay at all.	Feel wronged
Reporter	Why? Really? I can't believe it. And what's going on with your hands?	Shocked and feel sad.
Ahmad	I usually sew three soccer balls per day but my hands are injured so I didn't do as much as I could. My boss says if I can't meet his demand, I can't get paid.	Helpless and under pressure.
Reporter	Could you please tell me what happened to your fingers?	Shocked and feel sad.
Ahmad	They were stabbed by a needle, and I sometimes cut my fingers. I use a sharp knife to cut the end of the thread after tying the knot. Maybe I can show you how I work at the factory.	Helpless and in a bad mood.
