## The Process

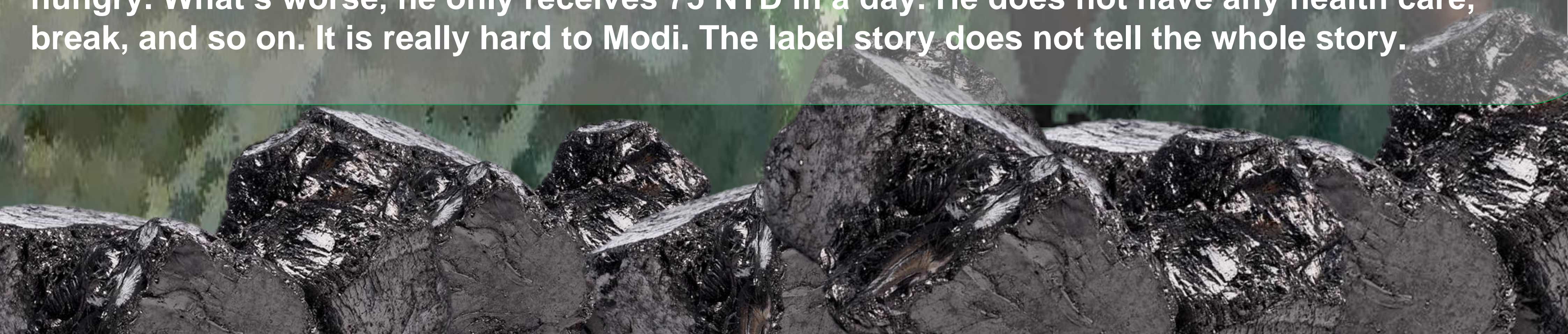
1. There are many coal companies in India, it is hard to find solid information (salary, working hours, law)
